

**Appendix B - Visitor Screening Questionnaire**

In order to maintain a safe environment during the COVID-19 pandemic, we require that all visitors to our schools and sites complete the following questionnaire prior to entering any school board facility.

Visitors must ensure at all times that they are following protocols for hand hygiene and physical distancing.

The questionnaire is intended to identify **new** symptoms or **worsening** of symptoms that are related to allergies, chronic conditions or pre-existing conditions. Visitors with symptoms related to pre-existing conditions or allergies can still attend the facility.

Do you have any of the following symptoms: fever, new onset of cough, worsening chronic cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?	Yes	No
Did you have a confirmed case of COVID-19 or have close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19?	Yes	No
Do you have two or more of the following symptoms - Sore throat - Hoarse voice - Difficulty swallowing - Decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell - Chills - Headaches - Unexplained fatigue/malaise - Diarrhea - Abdominal Pain - Nausea/vomiting - Pink eye (conjunctivitis) - Runny nose/sneezing without other known cause - Nasal congestion without other known cause	Yes	No

**If you answer “YES” to any of the above, you cannot attend any school board site at this time and, in accordance with Public Health directive, you must self-isolate and it is recommended that you get tested.**

**If you answer “NO” to all of the above, you may enter the school as long as you follow public health guidelines for hand hygiene and physical distancing as we work together to keep everyone safe.**

At the school, visitors must sign in confirming they are free of respiratory illness symptoms; have not travelled outside of Ontario and Canada within the last 14 days from the date of entry to the school; and have not cared for or had known contact with an individual with confirmed COVID-19, probable COVID-19 or COVID-19-like symptoms (fever, new cough, difficulty breathing).
